ON MAY 8, 1914, HE MADE THE FIRST FLIGHT OF A SEAPLANE
IN AUSTRALIA WHEN HE FLEW A FARMAN AIRCRAFT
FROM DOUBLE BAY.

THE AIRCRAFT BELONGED TO LEBBEUS HORDERN OF THE
ANTHONY HORDERN RETAIL STORE FAMILY.
