



FRENCH AVIATOR MAURICE GUILLAUX VISITED AUSTRALIA  
FROM APRIL TO OCTOBER 1914.

ON MAY 8, 1914, HE MADE THE FIRST FLIGHT OF A SEAPLANE  
IN AUSTRALIA, FLYING A FARMAN AIRCRAFT  
BELONGING TO LEBBEUS HORDERN  
OF THE ANTHONY HORDERN RETAIL STORE FAMILY.  
THE FLIGHT WAS MADE FROM DOUBLE BAY NEAR  
THE SITE OF THIS CLUBHOUSE.

ON MAY 12 2014 THIS EVENT WAS COMMEMORATED BY  
THE SEAPLANE PILOTS ASSOCIATION OF AUSTRALIA  
WITH A FLYPAST OVER SYDNEY.
